Figure Four-Ankle behind the knee joint



Scissors-Ankle off the knee joint and
crossed over the opposite leg



Figure 4 from neutral w/o arm-
Technical violation, delay call if safe



Figure 4 from neutral w/ arm-
Technical violation, delay call if safe



Figure 4 around body-
Illegal move, stop immediately



Figure 4 around both legs-
Illegal hold, stop immediately



Figure 4 around the head-
Legal hold, typically from a double armbar
situation



Figure 4 around head, change to an illegal scissors- typically from a double armbar situation, stop immediately



Figure 4 on leg-legal w/ no hyperextension

Figure 4, on leg w/ hyperextension-
illegal, stop immediately



Illegal scissors on head w/arm- pressure on neck, stop immediately



Illegal scissors on head w/o arm-stop immediately, pressure on neck



Draping head scissors w/ arm-
legal, no pressure on neck



Draping head scissors w/o arm-
legal, no pressure on neck



Scissors around body-
legal, if not used for punishment



Scissors on the head-
illegal from a granby position
